Tie up the top of the bag. (Any semi transparent plastic bag other than white is not accepted.) *It is planned that by the end of March 2022, it will be decided that only designated bags will be collected. Drain the food waste thoroughly. Soak cooking oil in paper, cloth or harden it with a coagulant. Soak unused fireworks and matches in water before disposing them. Remove feces from disposable diapers. If the futon does not fit in the bag, fold it one by one and tie it with a string. (Please separate double size and larger waste into oversized garbage.) When disposing of plants, cut them to a thickness of 5 cm or less and a length of 60 cm or less. Tie up the things that do not fit in the bag with a string.





Put waste in a commercially available transparent plastic bag (not translucent). If the items do not fit in the bag, bundle them with a string so that the items do not fall out. Do not put things made of metal, etc.

Rinse inside and outside with water. If the dirt does not come off, dispose them on the $\,$ burnable collection days.

dispose them on the burnable collection days.
